Harvest

October is the month when many of our churches celebrate harvest. Harvest used to be celebrated at the beginning of the season but now we usually celebrate in the autumn. It was a vicar from Morwenstow in Cornwall, the Rev. Robert Hawker, who shaped the thanksgiving service we know today. Probably the two best known harvest hymns are 'Come, ye thankful people come' written by an English cleric in 1844 and 'We plough the fields and scatter'. This latter hymn was translated from German at about the same time. 'All things bright and beautiful' is also often sung but makes no reference to harvest (apart from 'the ripe fruits in the garden' and 'the meadows where we play').

In the Eden valley several of our churches have harvest services this month, details are on the back page of the Memo. We are lucky to live in villages where farming is still a way of life. Our services are an opportunity to give thanks to God for the harvest, but also to give thanks for the farming families who have looked after this land for generations.

Do come along to one of our services, sing the well-known hymns and savour the produce which decorates our churches.

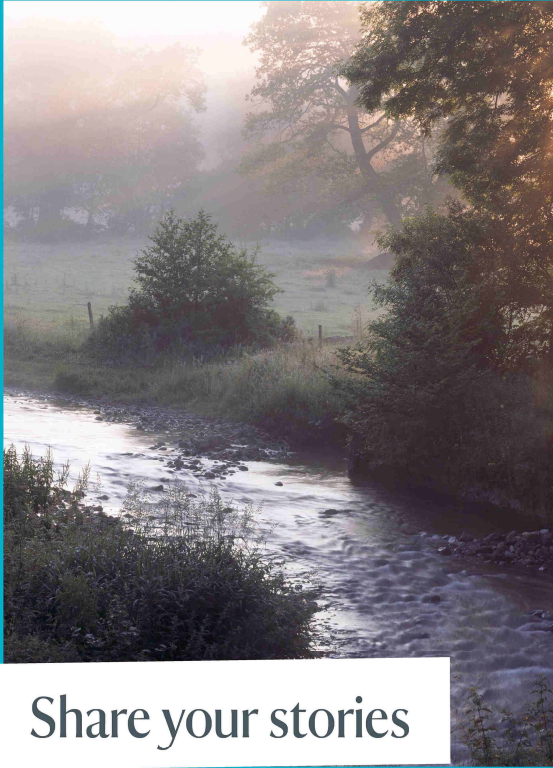
