

MidEdenMemo 4

Stumperies

I do enjoy looking around National Trust gardens like the one at Sizergh Castle, near Kendal. Look closely in one corner and you'll find the stumpery. Stumperies were very popular in Victorian England and were similar to rockeries. Whereas a rockery is a garden built around rocks, as the name suggests a stumpery is built around old stumps and dead wood. Out of the stumps, plants like ferns, mosses and lichens were growing, as well as being the homes for all sorts of insects and other wildlife. My grandchildren were amazed and delighted to find some beetles crawling along one old log.

It's also interesting that on many woodland estates managed by the National Trust (like at Acorn Bank), dead wood, fallen tree trunks and branches, are not cleared away and put onto the bonfire for particulates to add to the pollution of the atmosphere. Instead, piles of dead wood are strategically arranged so that insects, fungi and other wildlife, flora and fauna can make their home there.

New life springs up where there only seemed to be death, rot, and decay. Even when everything seems to have died, in fact new life is springing up. Life overcomes death.

To me, this is the central message of the Easter story - and indeed the Christian faith. When Jesus was crucified, it seemed that death had the victory. But, three days later he rose from the tomb. Death defeated. Light, love and life ultimately triumph over the darkness, hatred and decay!

Have a wonderful, hope-filled Easter!



Hartside First Responders

Hartside First Responders Team began in Gamblesby but since going live in 2011 has spread south along the fellside and west as far as the Eden. When we delivered some defibrillator training in Culgaith last year we discovered that the villages of Skirwith, Kirkland and Culgaith were orphans as they didn't fall within the area of a First Responder Team and we spoke to the ambulance service (NWAS) who agreed we could adopt them. In the Memo area if you call an ambulance and a First Responder attends it is most likely they will be a member of our team.

One of our number, Ian, is a qualified trainer and we will again be offering visits to your village halls and your WIs to provide training on steps you can take if you have a medical emergency – watch out for further details in this and future editions of the Memo.

First Responders are trained by NWAS and called out on the more serious categories of a medical emergency. We know what to do in the event of a cardiac arrest; we can supply oxygen and take observations (blood pressure, temperature etc) and help you pass those anxious minutes before the ambulance arrives, upgrading the call if we can see that the patient is deteriorating. You will know the importance of speed when it comes to dealing with cardiac arrest which is why we have public access defibrillators in many of our villages.

We can help people quickest if we live near where you live. At the moment we are quite thinly spread with Responders mainly in Ousby, Melmerby and Gamblesby. We would be delighted to welcome anyone from your village to join the team.
